

Our Trip to the Penn Museum




Soon I will be going on a field trip with my class to the Penn Museum.

We will then go with our museum teacher into a classroom.




Here we will learn about an ancient culture. The lesson will be fun.




If we are learning about ancient Egyptian mummies, I will get a sash to wear.

who look dead.**




**But we should not be afraid because

shoulders that look like this!**




We will also see a brain but it is made of jello, so we should not be afraid.

If I'd like some quiet time, I can look at [the map](#) with my teacher and find a quiet space.




**After I am done eating I will throw

Many of the artifacts in the Museum are damaged from being so old.




It is important that we don't touch the artifacts and damage them more.

the stairs.**




If I cannot walk up the stairs I can take the elevator with an adult.
